





- 2 white one-inch three-ring binders with protective sleeve cover
- 3 wide-ruled composition notebooks (marbled cover)
- 5 three-hole plastic folders red, blue, yellow, green, and orange (not All Star brand; not with prongs)
- 1 clipboard
- I zippered pouch to fit in binder
- 1 supply box (8.5" X 5")
- I package of Ticonderoga #2 pencils
- I pack of cap erasers for pencils
- 1 box of 24 crayons OR 1 pack of colored pencils
- 4 BLACK dry erase markers
